



HOW TO SUPPORT THE GUELPH STUDENT FOODBANK?

Thank you so much for thinking about us. Your desire to support students is instrumental to keeping our services running. There are many ways you can help!

DONATE:

We accept cash, cheque, and e-transfer donations.

- **Cash** donations can be **dropped off in-person** either at the FoodBank or the CSA office (located on the 2nd floor of the UC).
- **Cheques** can be made out to the Central Student Association, with **Guelph Student FoodBank** written in the **memo line**. These can be dropped off in the CSA office.
- **E-transfers** can be directed to: csaaccts@uoguelph.ca from your banking software. In the **message field**, state that it is a **donation for the Food Bank**. (Don't forget the message or else the CSA won't know where to direct the donation!)

Unfortunately, we cannot provide tax receipts.

We also accept food item donations, such as canned tuna, peanut butter, beans, rice, and lentils. Food item donations must be **non-perishable, not past best before dates** and **not opened or dented**. Please call/email in advance to arrange a drop-off time or to inquire about our current most-needed items.

ORGANIZE:

Organizing a fundraiser or food drive is a great way to connect people on campus to help support our cause! We're happy to work with individuals, groups, and organizations who are interested in getting involved. We can chat and I can support you with advertising materials or bins that can be loaned.

VOLUNTEER:

We currently are unable to accept volunteers. Contact the FoodBank Coordinator to be added to our Volunteer Interest list. They can also make recommendations to food-related organizations on or off campus that are recruiting volunteers.
