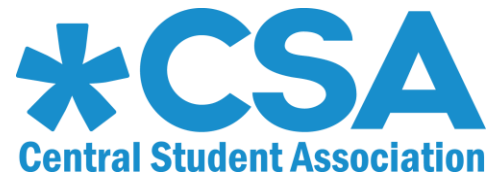

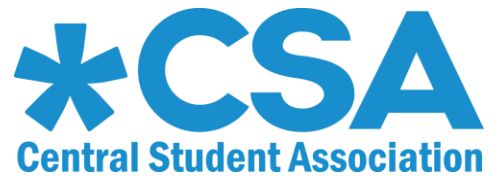

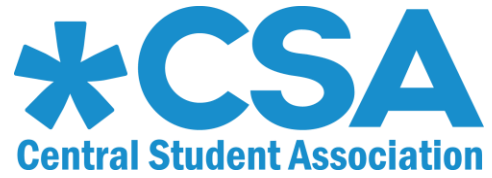

Winter 2026 General Election Unofficial Results

How the Results Were Calculated:

For Executive positions (President, VP Internal, VP Academic, VP External), we utilized Ranked Choice Voting (RCV), also known as Instant Runoff Voting. In this system, voters rank candidates in order of preference. If no candidate receives over 50% of the first-place votes, the candidate with the fewest votes is eliminated, and their votes are reallocated to the next preferred candidate on those ballots. This process continues in rounds until one candidate achieves a majority of over 50% and is declared the winner. For Director positions, where two seats were available for each college, we employed a Borda Count system. With Borda Count, voters rank candidates, and points are assigned based on those rankings. For example, in a race with four candidates, a first-place vote might receive 4 points, a second-place vote 3 points, and so on. The points for each candidate are tallied, and the two candidates with the highest total scores are elected.

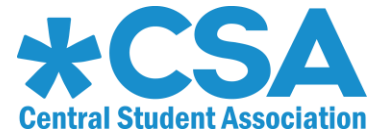
GBSA Referendum: Quorum NOT Met
